Chairperson's Words

In 2020, the word on everyone's mind all over the world was "Covid-19". To meet the uphill battle of the pandemic, we had to be even more flexible, more creative, and continue to provide our services without interruption while still limiting social contact.

In 2020, Hotline substantially expanded its online community and operated a regular YouTube program, "Hotline Tea Room" alongside a variety of podcasts to reach more LGBTQ+ people across all corners of Taiwan. The office has implemented epidemic prevention measures, changed many in person activities to online activities, and continued to participate in online seminars and forums around the world to maintain friendly international exchanges and cooperation. This year Hotline also published the Chinese-speaking world's first mature lesbian life story "Grandma's Girlfriend", and as the epidemic improved towards the end of the year, Hotline was able to successfully hold the second annual Taiwan Transgender Parade! Amid the pandemic, the all-encompassing control and privacy, governance and freedom, feelings of isolation and intimacy all seemed to pull us in many different directions whilst seemingly wrapping each and every one of us in an embrace. Considering these circumstances, these achievements were hard won.

After two terms of office, I will step down as Chairman of the Board of Directors in 2021. In the past four years, the LGBTQ+ community in Taiwan has experienced ups and downs, however fortunately, the LGBTQ+ community is always lovely and resilient! And of course, so is everyone at Hotline! We will always be strong and continue to work hard on the front line!

HIV/AIDS Services

1.Anonymous HIV / Syphillis screening and consultation service: we provided the service every Tuesday and Wednesday evening for a total of 352 individuals. We also accompanied 7 individuals to a medical consultation.

LGBTQ+ Elderly and Multiple Identities

 "My grandmother's lover" was published in October 2020.
Over the course of 8 years, interviewing 17 lesbian women over the age of 55, and won the 2020 Openbook Good Book Award for Life Book of the Year!

2. Operation of "The story of Time - 18 Tips for LGBTQ+ People" Podcast

In order to cope with the Covid-19 pandemic situation in 2020, the Mature LGBTQ+ small group stopped organizing activities that required physical contact (such as meetings of the Mature Gay Women small group, Story of Time forums, mature rainbow bus, etc.). However, in order to continue serving the LGBTQ+ community, to advocate for various topics and to make LGBTQ+ friends from all over the world not feel alone, the Mature LGBTQ+ small group began to develop a plan for the LGBTQ+ Celebrations of life, death, illness and long term care podcast. At present, it has launched two seasons with a total of 27 episodes. Topics include special talks from prominent LGBTQ+ Figures, Mature Lesbian lecture series, Celebration of LGBTQ+ Life series, Diverse Family with pets series, cross generation LGBTQ+ life experience dialogue, historical accounts of LGBTQ+ movements and long-term care for life, old age, illness, and death of LGBTQ+ People series.

3.Senior Lesbians Chat:

This year, a total of seven chat sessions were held, including one in Hsinchu to serve the local female LGBTQ+ community members, with 150 participants. In addition, the "Book Meeting: speed dating for mature women" activity was held to provide a comfortable channel for lesbian to make more friends. A total of 34 mature lesbians participated in the activity.

3. LGBTQ+ with disabilities:

A Rainbow Taiwan Sign Language class was held with 15 participants.

We have cooperated with HandAngel to hold 15 sessions of the "Physical/Mental disability and Gender Diversity Group", and "Experience Sharing on Sexual Equality for the Disabled" to discuss the issue of sexual rights in Taiwan's multi-year push for the Barrier Free Environment Law.

4. Long term care speeches for medical sectors: 13 sessions, 615 attendees.

2020 Survey on the campus experience of Taiwan's LGBTQ+ students

Hotline Annual Fundraising Thanksgiving Meeting

1 session at Spero, in addition to fundraising, it also provided a window for the outside world to better understand the Hotline's annual work content, as well as promoting the cohesion within the gay community through a variety gay-related performances, allowing us to gain even more energy in the LGBT movement.

For four consecutive years, we have carried out elderly welfare and gay friendly exchange programs with the Neihu Center, and hope that with this work experience as the foundation, we can expand to every elderly center in Taipei, allowing the staff members and volunteers in Taipei's long-term care system to amicably accept the gay community through understanding them.

A total of 3 exchange meetings were held, as well as a cooking competition called "Grandma's One Dish", which was held between the Center's volunteers and the gay exchange participants, A total of 32 elderly people participated.

LGBTQ+ Friendship Activities ft. Datong District Office

The Hotline and Datong district in collaboration: 2020 "Love Dadaocheng", the first non-heterosexual networking event organized by the Taipei City Government. A total of two events, could only admit 32 people, but it attracted over a hundred people to sign up.
